Sharon Stein is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Educational Studies at the University of British Columbia in Canada, and a Visiting Professor with the Chair for Critical Studies in Higher Education Transformation at Nelson Mandela University in South Africa. Her research examines the complexities and challenges of internationalization, decolonization, and sustainability in higher education. Through this work, she seeks to interrupt common colonial patterns of educational engagement, including: uneven and extractive relationships between dominant and marginalized communities; simplistic solutions to complex problems; and ethnocentric imaginaries of justice, responsibility, and change. She is the founder of the Critical Internationalization Studies Network, and a founding member of the Gesturing Towards Decolonial Futures collective. Her book, Unsettling the University: Confronting the Colonial Foundations of US Higher Education, will be released from Johns Hopkins University Press in Fall 2022.
