## Trish Greenhalgh

Trish Greenhalgh is Professor of Primary Care Health Sciences and Director of the Interdisciplinary Research in Health Sciences research group at the University of Oxford. She studied Medical, Social and Political Sciences at Cambridge and Clinical Medicine at Oxford before training first as a diabetologist and later as an academic general practitioner. She has a doctorate in laboratory science, an MBA in Higher Education Management and four honorary doctorates. She leads a programme of research at the interface between medicine, the social sciences and philosophy. She has brought this interdisciplinary perspective to bear on the research response to the Covid-19 pandemic, looking at diverse themes including remote clinical assessment of the deteriorating patient, the science and anthropology of masking for the lay public, and policy decision-making at times of crisis. Trish is the author of over 400 peer-reviewed publications and 16 textbooks. She holds various national and international advisory appointments and is a member of Independent SAGE.
